Philanthropy Roundtable initially screens nominees to determine Prize eligibility. Eligible nominees receive additional background research to supplement their nomination, after which Philanthropy Roundtable presents to the selection committee the candidates it believes most merit consideration.

The selection committee chooses the award recipient through a ranking process and discussion during a Zoom meeting on Wednesday, May 20, 2026, at 3:30 PM ET. **The 2026 Nomination Ranking Form must be submitted by May 15, 2026, at 12:30 PM ET.** The recipient of the DeVos Family Prize for Leadership in Giving must be available to speak at Philanthropy Roundtable’s Annual Meeting this fall, where he or she will be officially recognized.

Active funder or donor status is neither a positive nor negative eligibility criterion. Members of the DeVos family are not eligible. Recipients are selected without regard to race, color, creed, gender, or national origin. No nominator or director may benefit directly or indirectly from the selection of any nominee.
